

Patient Care Unit Descriptions

ICUs

Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center

- **4ICU:** MICU – patients with medical diagnoses – diabetes, sepsis, oncology, respiratory, neuro-muscular, etc.
- **7N CCU:** patients with acute MI, cardiogenic shock, IAPB, cardiomyopathy, heart transplant rejection, etc.
- **7ICU:** Cardiothoracic ICU – adult/pediatric heart surgery-CABG, valves, adult congenital, heart/lung transplant, heart assist devices, IAPB, thoracic surgery
- **8ICU:** Liver Transplant/Surgical ICU – patients in liver failure awaiting transplant, liver transplant, small bowel/pancreas transplant, kidney transplant, general surgery
- **6ICU:** Neuro/Trauma ICU – patients with bleeds, stroke, seizures, tumors, head or body trauma

- **CCU/Med – Surg ICU:** patients with medical, surgical and cardiac diagnoses

INTERMEDIATE CARE

- **7W:** Cardiothoracic Surgical Unit – CABG, valves, adult congenital, lung evaluations/transplants, thoracic surgery
- **7N:** COU – angioplasty, stents, pacer implants, AICD, cardiomyopathy, ACE unit (evaluation for heart transplant, heart failure), heart assist devices, heart transplants
- **7E:** Acute Medicine Unit – patients with varied medical diagnoses: sickle cell, diabetes, liver failure, sarcoidosis, scleroderma, respiratory failure, kidney failure, etc.
- **6N:** Neurosurgery/Neurology Intermediate Care Unit: bleeds, seizure disorders, brain tumors, head trauma and stroke, and ECG

- **6 Tower:** patients requiring monitoring – cardiology, R/O MI, pacers, AICDs, cardiac surgery, general medicine, general surgery, geriatrics, ventilator support
- **3 South Tower:** Geriatrics Step Down

MEDICAL SURGERY SPECIALTY FLOORS

- **8N:** Liver Transplant Unit – patients being evaluated and waiting for transplant (liver, small bowel/pancreas)
- **8W:** General Surgery Floor – urology, head/neck, kidney transplant surgical unit
- **6W:** Ortho Trauma, Plastics, Vascular Surgery, and EEG Monitoring
- **8E:** General, Gynecology, Liver, and other surgical services
- **6E:** Oncology – hematology, autologous/BMT/stem cell/interleukin therapy

- **4 South West:** Solid tumor & medical oncology
- **8 Tower:** general medicine/palliative care – varied medical diagnoses
- **4 Merle Norman Pavilion:** orthopaedic surgery and neuro-spine
- **5 Merle Norman Pavilion:** med/surg

MATTEL CHILDREN’S HOSPITAL

- **Pediatrics:** general pediatrics, neonates to adolescents – cardiology, cardiac surgery, heart transplant, cardiomyopathy, congenital liver disease, liver transplant, inflammatory bowel diseases, small bowel transplant/pancreas transplant, diabetes, neurology/neurosurgery/seizure disorders, respiratory diseases, etc.
- **PICU:** all of the above diseases and surgeries requiring ICU level care, including trauma; cardiac surgery/transplant is in the cardiac surgery ICU
- **NICU:** Level III – neonates with varied diagnoses including preemies, cardiac, neuro, pulmonary ecmo, etc.

- **NICU:** Level II – neonates with varied diagnoses – multiple births, preemies, general surgery
- **Pediatrics:** general and orthopaedic

LABOR AND DELIVERY

- **Labor and Delivery/Maternity and Newborn Nursery:** high-risk L&D patients with varied medical diagnoses – cardiac, neuro, diabetes, etc.

- **Labor and Delivery/Antepartum/Postpartum:** community hospital L&D – multiple births, pre-term labor, etc.

EMERGENCY

- **David Saperstein Emergency Center** - Level I trauma with base station

- **Nethercutt Emergency Department** - Level II trauma

- **4N:** Med Psych Unit – adult eating disorder and geriatric psych
- **4E:** Adult Psychiatry – Adult acute, adult ICU, and substance abuse
- **4W:** Adolescent and child psychiatry – behavior and adolescent eating disorders

OPERATING ROOM
